“Changeless Truths for a Changing World” 1 Peter 1:13-2:3

- I. Introduction: Much has changed in the world since Joseph was sold to Potiphar.

- II. In our changing world...
 - A. Modern technology has increased the speed with which change spreads.

 - B. Our lives are less community-based and more individualistic.

 - C. We are pressed to embrace a radical diversity of social and moral norms.
 1. Religiously-speaking, this arises from a rejection of God’s sovereign authority.
 2. Each human is exalted to the highest place and assigned personal sovereignty and moral authority.

- III. The Bible’s changeless truths:
 - A. Human nature remains corrupt and mired in sin.

 - B. Our source of hope for the future is found in God’s living and enduring word.
 1. God’s word stands...his promises have been fulfilled.
 2. God’s word is the imperishable seed that brings us new birth.
 - C. God’s Word contains enduring truth for all areas of our lives.
